Humanity's Final Golden Age: A Precursor to Collapse

Both Organizations concealed themselves and their activity through innocuous-sounding shell companies; Aperture hid behind "Arbeit Communications" a rather bland telecommunications firm used to mask complex research; as for Black Mesa... they used a variety of various companies and military logistics to hide their core projects.

Then, in the year **2001**, the veil was violently torn away.

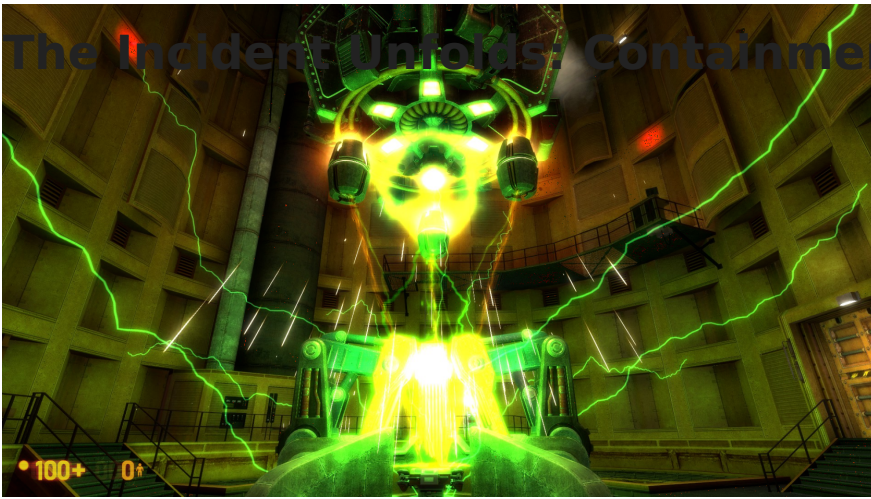

The precise timeline of the Black

Mesa Incident remains shrouded in classified documentation, corrupted archives, and scattered eyewitness accounts.
